

# Emergency Kit Supplies Checklist

## Basic Home Emergency Kit

- ☐ Water (1 gallon per person per day for at least 3 days)
- ☐ Non-perishable food (3-day supply per person)
- ☐ Battery-powered or hand crank radio
- ☐ NOAA Weather Radio
- ☐ Flashlight
- ☐ Extra batteries
- ☐ First aid kit
- ☐ Whistle
- ☐ Dust mask
- ☐ Plastic sheeting
- ☐ Duct tape
- ☐ Moist towelettes
- ☐ Garbage bags and ties
- ☐ Manual can opener
- ☐ Cell phone with chargers and backup battery
- ☐ Additional supplies based on family needs (medications, baby supplies, pet food, etc.)

## Portable "Go Bag"

- ☐ Backpack or easy-to-carry container
- ☐ Copies of important documents in a waterproof container
- ☐ Extra cash and change
- ☐ Emergency blanket
- ☐ Map(s) of the area
- ☐ Extra set of car and house keys

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## Vehicle Emergency Kit

- ☐ Jumper cables
- ☐ Flares or reflective triangle
- ☐ Ice scraper
- ☐ Car cell phone charger
- ☐ Blanket
- ☐ Cat litter or sand (for better tire traction)

## First Aid Kit

- ☐ Variety of bandages and gauze pads
- ☐ Antiseptic wipes
- ☐ Antibiotic ointment
- ☐ Pain relievers
- ☐ Other essential medications
- ☐ Tweezers
- ☐ Scissors
- ☐ Instant cold compress
- ☐ Non-latex gloves

## Maintenance

- ☐ Check expiration dates and replace items as needed
- ☐ Update kits as your family's needs change
- ☐ Ensure everyone knows where kits are located
